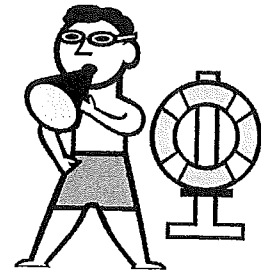
Turn in the application to the Business Office. We will contact you afterward for an interview.

Lifeguard Prerequisites:

Must be at least 16 years old.

Must be able to swim 300 yards continuously.

Obtain a **Work Permit**, if under the age of 18.



1. Obtain a work permit application at your local high school (or the application form may be downloaded from the California State Department of Education website (<http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlse/dlse-cl.htm> (click: "Statement of Intent to Employ Minor and Request for Work Permit"))
2. Fill out the personal information at the top of the application, get your prospective employer to fill out the information required in the middle portion (email me or stop by Business Office), and have a parent or guardian sign the bottom portion of the application.
3. Return the completed work permit application to your high school where the work permit will be processed and typed.
4. Bring the typed work permit back to the prospective employer (BRING TO INTERVIEW).
