Additional fees include:

A non-refundable registration fee per family of \$125.00 due at registration.

A deposit equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ month tuition due by June 1, 2016 to hold your child's spot. This money will be applied to the June 2017 tuition, and is refundable if you move before that time & give a 30 day notice.

A birth certificate and updated immunization record is required at the time of registration, along with the registration fee. Preschool handbooks and required State Licensing forms for your child's file will be available to take home once your child is registered.
