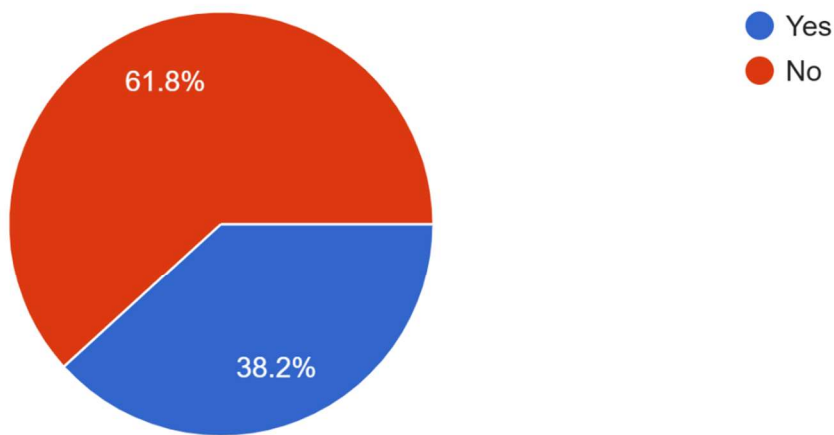


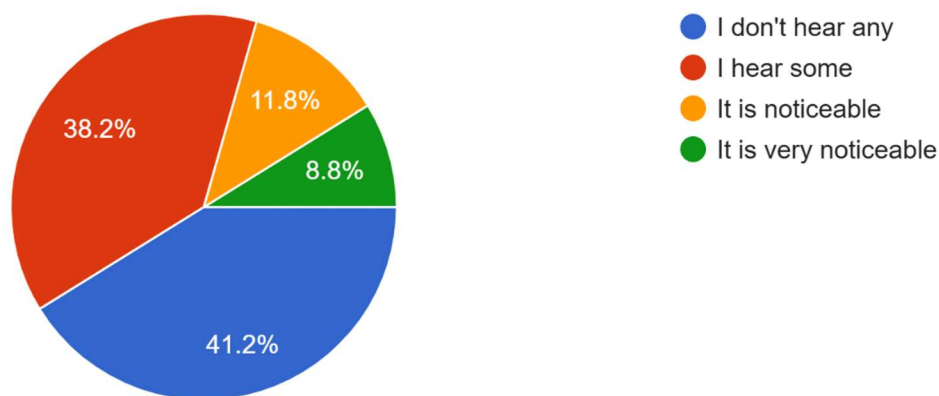
CHOA PICKLEBALL SURVEY RESULTS – NEARBY HOMES

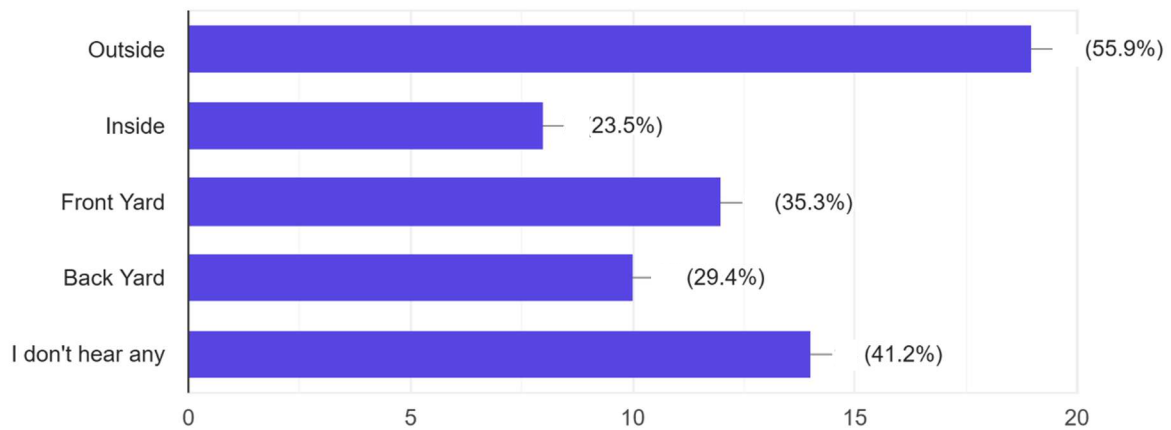
2. Do you or anyone in your home play pickleball on our CHOA courts?



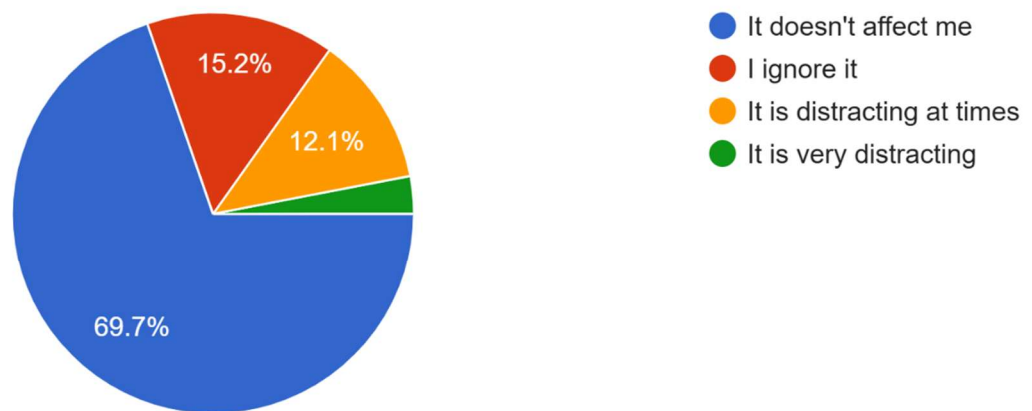
3. How would you describe sound from play on our CHOA pickleball courts? Choose one



4. Where at your home do you hear the pickleball sound? Choose all that apply

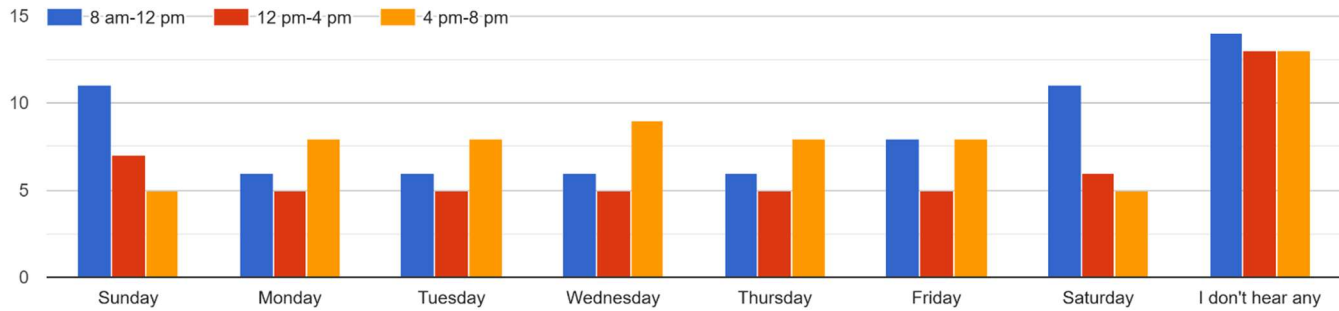


5. How does pickleball sound affect you? Choose one

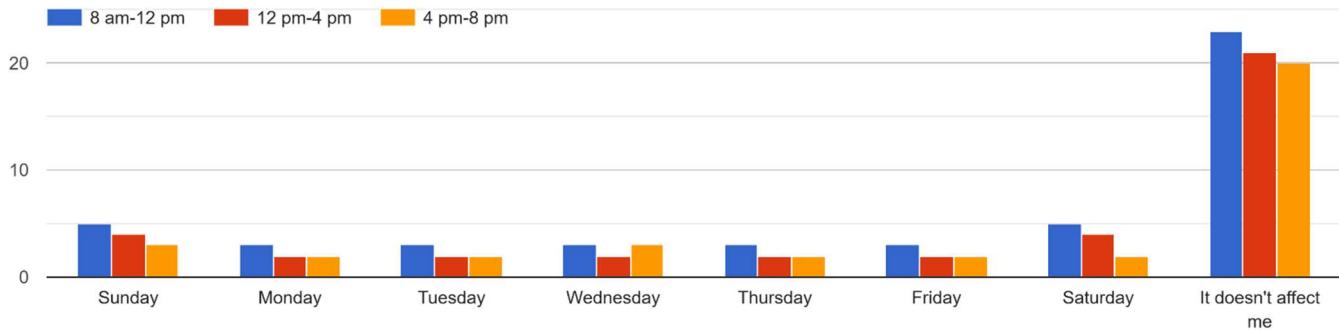

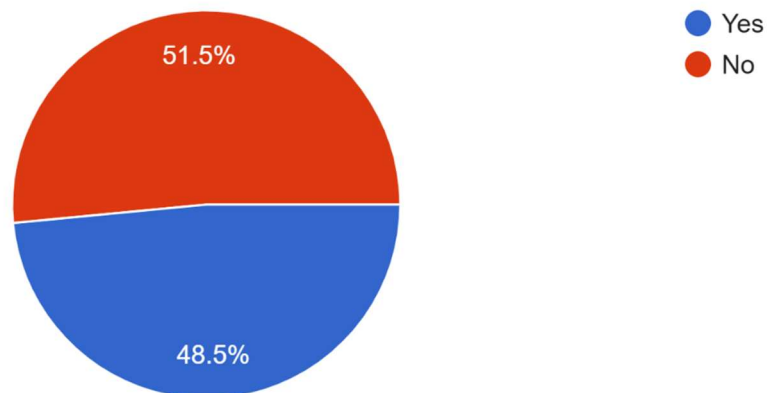
6. When do you hear pickleball play? Choose all at apply



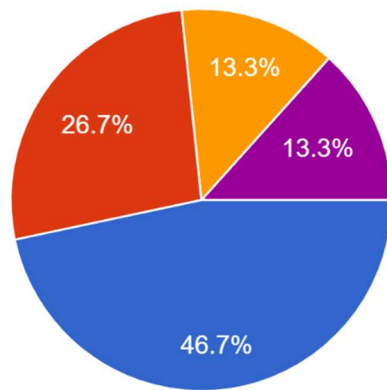
7. When does the sound of pickleball play affect you most? Choose all at apply



8. Did you notice a change in the pickleball sound after the sound barrier was added?

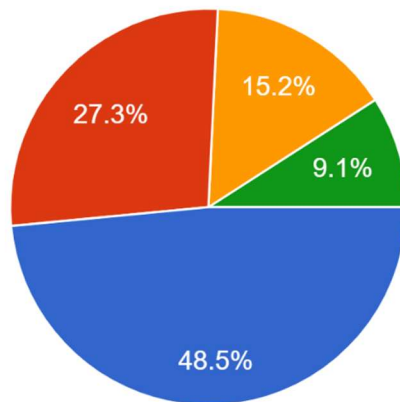
